Any change of the information above mentioned must be reported and documented to the Colombian Civil Aviation Authority (UAEAC).

Concerning to the Post Type Validation Procedure, the Colombian Civil Aviation Authority (UAEAC) will accept the CAAI findings for all post-Type Validation changes to the Type Design (including design change approvals, Aircraft Flight Manual (AFM) approvals, Airworthiness Limitations (AWL) approvals, Service Bulletin (SB) approvals, Continuing Airworthiness). In addition, the CAAL as State of Design for the GALAXY and GULFSTREAM 200 will have overall responsibilities for Continued Airworthiness.

Note: According with certification basis of CAAI TC No. A6IL, Compliance Check List (CCL) document number 4AS/000/98192 and Basis of Certification document number 4AS/090/951608 this authority also accepts the FAA TC A53NM (Import).
